NTW for All Walks of Life

NTW enrolment reflects strong participation from all walks of life including students, youths, working adults and senior citizens.

While participation shifted from female majority in 2023 to male majority in 2025, engagement remained broad and inclusive.

Youths aged 19 to 40 continue to dominate, supported by growing student participation and a rebound among working adults, reinforcing NTW as a national platform for lifelong learning across every stage of life.
